Waterbury West

Waterbury West is a 3.5 Level of care residential substance use treatment that provides a structured environment and comprehensive treatment services for adult men with substance use disorders, and is co-occurring capable. Referrals are accepted from the Connecticut Court Support Services Division, the Department of Correction and Federal Probation, as well as from individuals and community providers. The length of stay is individualized based on client needs.

Waterbury West provides a structured recovery environment, staffed 24 hours a day, which provides sufficient stability to prevent or minimize relapse or continued use through high-intensity clinical and recovery-focused services.

The comprehensive team includes nursing staff, licensed clinicians, group facilitators, support staff and Peer Recovery Specialists. Clients are assisted with discharge planning, housing and employment, and referrals to other organizations for sustainability of treatment gains and long-term assistance based on their individual needs. The program consists of one four-story building, with treatment space on each floor, client bedrooms on the second, third and fourth floors, and group treatment rooms.

For recreation Waterbury West has a weight room and outdoor recreation area.

The goal of the program is to help each individual to take the first step toward achieving sobriety, while effecting a global change in lifestyle, attitudes and values in support of lifelong recovery and community reintegration. Medicaid accepted.
